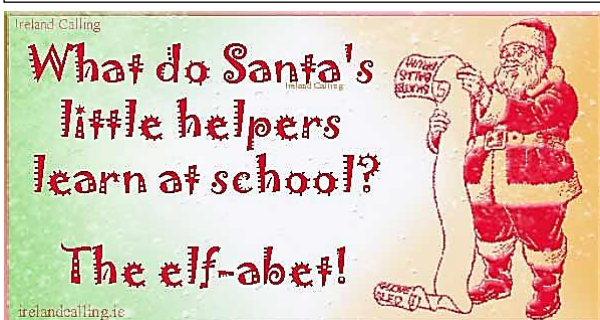
A Christmas message

Topic

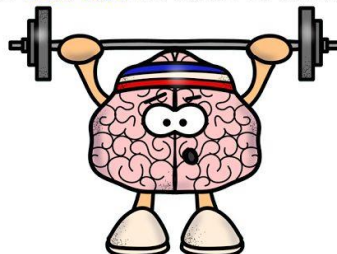
