Topic

Numeracy

In Numeracy this month, we are:

- revising multiplication and division facts for all of the tables we have learned so far;
- learning multiplication facts for the 11 times tables;
- revising the sequence of months and the number of days in each month;
- reading calendars to identify the day, given the date, and vice-versa;
- extending calendar work to **finding** durations, in weeks or days, which 'bridge' consecutive months;
- learning how to read the time in 5 minute intervals on analogue and digital displays;
- writing times in 5 minute intervals, using 12-hour notation and am/pm; and
- learning how to read and write the time in 1 minute intervals on analogue and digital displays using 12-hour notation and am/pm.
