#### Attendance & Punctuality

Likewise, many of our pupils are arriving late for school. Getting to school on time is not the responsibility of our pupils – it is the responsibility of parents.

## SAFER INTERNET DAY

# SAFER INTERNET FOR PARENTS

There will be an adult workshop (delivered by REIM) on **Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> February** at 7pm which aims to educate parents in the practical skills needed to set up parental controls and protect children on-line while using PC/Laptop, Android, or 'l' device. Knowledge on how to keep children safe while using some of the frequently used social media sites and tips on dealing with cyberbullying will also be provided.

The programme will cover the following topics:

- Social Networking/ Online Gaming /Online Gambling /Inappropriate material
- Cyberbullying
- "Hot" Web Sites current sites that may cause concern e.g., Omegle, Monkey

• Computer / Internet Parental Controls to include: Set up User Accounts (for individual children), Operating System Controls (age specific), Internet Browser Security, Safe Searching and Internet Filters
